Robinson Padilla Vargas, 78, of Old Bridge, NJ, passed away on Monday, July 27, 2020 at the Raritan Bay Medical Center in Old Bridge, NJ.

Robinson was born on February 15, 1942 to Augustine Padilla and Rosa Vargas, in Cabo Rojo, Puerto Rico. On March 10, 1962, he married Andrea Dieppa Sanchez and lived in Newark, NJ until 1990. He returned to the island he loved so dearly to enjoy more time with his siblings and tropical weather. He was a laborer for 65 years working for a window manufacturer in Saddlebrook, NJ and a metal plating company in Caguas, PR before retiring in 2007.

Robinson and Andrea lived in Gurabo, PR and moved to Old Bridge one year ago.

Robinson suffered an ischemic stroke in 2017 and returned to NJ to be near his immediate family.

Robinson was an avid bowler winning multiple trophies on various teams. He also loved spending time at the casinos although he was not a big gambler.

Robinson is survived by his loving wife of 58, years, Andrea; two daughters and their husbands, Lily and Rosendo Petrovich, and Gresly and Luis Algarin; his brother, Rene Padilla; two sisters, Santa Padilla, and Georgina Padilla; his granddaughter and husband, Erika and Francesco DeFelice, granddaughter Brianna Algarin; two grandsons, Evan Petrovich, and Ryan Algarin; and his great-granddaughter, Adrianna DeFelice.
